CIRCULAR

An emergent meeting of Coordination Committee of all District Bar Associations of Delhi was held today after the circular from the office of the Commissioner of Police, Delhi dated 04.09.2025 regarding examination of police witnesses via Audio Video electronic means from Police Stations.

A delegation comprising representatives of Coordination Committee and Bar Council of Delhi met Union Home Minister on 02.09.2025 to apprise the resentment amongst the legal fraternity of Delhi against the Notification dated 13.08.2025 issued by Governor of Delhi designating the police stations of Delhi as the place to record evidence of police officers.

After deliberation and discussion, it was assured by the Union Home Minister that an official correspondence/circular shall be issued to clarify that examination of police officials shall not take place from the police stations. However, today's communication from the office of Commissioner of Police is not in line with the final outcome and assurance given by Union Home Minister to the delegation of Coordination Committee of Delhi.
