UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following O R D E R

- 1. Pursuant to the order dated 17.10.2025, we have briefly heard the learned Attorney General for India as well as the learned Solicitor General of India. A brief note put up by the Central Bureau of Investigation has also been perused. The State of Haryana has also entered appearance.
- 2. It is pointed out by learned Additional Advocate General of Haryana that besides the two FIRs mentioned in paragraph 2 of our order dated 17.10.2025, there are more cases registered in the States/Union Territories relating to the offence of cyber arrest. He seeks and is granted one week's time to furnish the details of those FIRs as well.

- 3. Meanwhile, let notice be issued to all the States and Union Territories through their standing counsel, returnable on 03.11.2025.
- 4. The States and Union Territories are directed to furnish details of the cases of cyber arrest pending investigation in their respective jurisdiction. In this regard they need not file any formal counter affidavit.
- 5. Post the matter on 03.11.2025.
