UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. In this writ petition filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners' grievance appears to be that the Dispute No.CC/I/17 of 2017, which is stated to be a dispute under Section 91 of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act, 1960 and which pertains to recovery of an aggregate amount of Rs.20,98,88,815.93 has not been decided by the Cooperative Court No.1, Mumbai.

2. It seems that, earlier, a petition was filed for expeditious disposal of the matter before the High Court, but that petition came to be disposed of as infructuous on 02.05.2023.

3. Since the Presiding Officer of the Court had earlier, on an application moved by the petitioners, expressed his helplessness to

decide the case out of turn on account of heavy pendency, it seems to us that the appropriate recourse for the petitioners would be to approach the High Court of Judicature at Bombay afresh, which, being the Administrative High Court, will be in a position to effectively redress the petitioners' grievance. Ordered accordingly.

4. We request the High Court to look into the grievance raised by the petitioners.

5. The Writ Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

6. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
